TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE; CONFIRMING ERNEST DISWOOD TO SERVE ON THE NAVAJO AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS INDUSTRY BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR A TERM OF THREE YEARS REPRESENTING DISTRICT 13

PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to confirm Ernest Diswood to the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry's Board of Directors For a Term of Three (3) Years Representing the District 13.

Final Authority: Resources and Development Committee

Vote Required: Simple Majority

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review the proposed resolution in detail.

27	A. Pursuant to 5 N.N.C. § 1603 (B), the Navajo Agricultural Products Indust	ry (or

- under contract a Chief Financial Officer. The Chief Financial Officer shall be accountable to the Board of the Directors and to the Chief Executive Officer and shall be supervised by the Chief Executive Officer in conformity with job descriptions established for the Chief Financial Officer and the Chief Executive Officer, and with Navajo Agricultural Products Industry's approved policies and procedures. The Chief Financial Officer shall submit all monthly, quarterly and annual reports to the Chief Executive Officer and Board of Directors simultaneously."
- B. Pursuant to 5 N.N.C. § 1603(D), "[n]o elected official of the federal, state or Navajo Nation government shall be a member of the Board of Directors. No employee of the federal, state or Navajo Nation government shall be a member of the Board of Directors."
- C. Pursuant to 5 N.N.C. § 1604, "[t]he Navajo Agricultural Products Industry shall operate under the legislative oversight of the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council...NAPI shall operate pursuant to a Plan of Operation recommended by the NAPI Board of Directors in consultation with the President of the Navajo Nation and adopted by the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council."
- D. Pursuant to RDCS-049-19, the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry's Amended Plan of Operation, Article 5 (A), "NAPI shall be managed by a Board of Directors that shall provide governance and oversight of the organization, subject to the restrictions of this Plan of Operation and applicable law. The Board shall consist of five (5) members from the Western, Chinle, and Eastern Agencies of the Navajo Nation. At least one Director shall be from District 13 and one Director shall be from District 19."
- E. Pursuant to RDCS-049-19, the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry's Amended Plan of Operation, Article (C) and (D) state the qualifications and term of service: "(C) Qualifications. Each Director shall have substantial business experience which shall include, but not be limited to agribusiness and/or business marketing, livestock, agricultural economics and finance, irrigation and P.L. 93-638

contracting. It is preferred that each Director shall have knowledge of corporate and/or business financial statements and capital investment planning and shall possess a Bachelor's degree from a recognized and accredited four-year institution of higher learning. Preference in the appointment of Directors shall be given to Navajos...(D) Term of Office. Directors shall serve staggered terms of three (3) years and may be reappointed to serve additional terms."

- F. The President of the Navajo Nation, by letter dated May 1, 2024, attached as Exhibit A, states that Ernest Diswood meets the requirements of 5 N.N.C. § 1603(D) and the Navajo Agricultural Product Industry's Plan of Operation and has appointed Ernest Diswood to the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry Board of Directors to represent District 13.
- G. Ernest Diswood's letter of interest, resume, and Certificate of Navajo Indian Blood are attached hereto as **Exhibits B**, **C**, and **D**, respectively.

## SECTION THREE. CONFIRMATION

The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby confirms the appointment of Ernest Diswood to the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry Board of Directors for a term of three years representing District 13.
