17	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
18	A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the	
19	Navajo Nation Council which oversees Navajo Nation efforts in implementing and	
20	ensuring compliance with employment and labor laws and policies of the Navajo	
21	Nation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 400(A) & 400(C)(3).	
22	B. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is authorized to appoint two	
23	members to the Navajo Nation Labor Commission. 15 N.N.C. § 303(A). See Also,	
24	CJY-40-22.	
25	C. Members of the Commission serve for a term of four (4) years until their successor is	
26	appointed. 15 N.N.C. § 303(D).

28	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
29	A. The purpose of the Navajo Nation Labor Commission "to operate as a quasi-judicial	
30	body to hear, adjudicate, and decide all complaints filed under the Navajo Preference	

- in Employment Act (the "Act") in accordance with its rules of procedure in an unbiased manner." 15 N.N.C. § 302.
- B. The Labor Commission ("Commission") consists of five members who are licensed by the Navajo Nation Bar Association. In addition, two of the Commission members must bar licensed attorneys in the state of Arizona, New Mexico or Utah. 15 N.N.C. § 303 (A) & (B).
- C. The membership of the Commission consists of two members appointed by the Health, Education and Human Services Committee and three members appointed by the President of the Navajo Nation., with concurrence of the Naabik'íyáti Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 15 N.N.C. § 303 (A).
- D. Richie Nez, Sr. meets the qualifications set forth at 15 N.N.C. 303(B), as he is a licensed member of the Navajo Nation Bar Association, and familiar with the Navajo Nation's labor practices, human resources, and employment. Exhibit A.
- E. Therefore, it's in the best interest of the Health, Education and Human Services Committee to appoint Mr. Richie Nez, Sr. as a Navajo Nation Labor Commissioner.

SECTION THREE. APPOINTMENT CONFIRMATION

The Health, Education and Human Services Committee hereby appoints Mr. Richie Nez, Sr. to the Navajo Nation Labor Committee. Mr. Richie Nez, Sr. shall serve a 4-year term to commence on the day of his confirmation by the Health, Education and Human Services Committee.
