16	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
17 18	A. In July of 2020, the Navajo Nation Council created the COVID-19 Response Donation Fund	
	in Resolution No. CJY-52-20. The purpose of the COVID-19 Fund is to collect donations	
19 20	from all sources for the Navajo Nation's COVID-19 relief activities. CJY-52-20 is	
21	incorporated herein by this reference.	
22	B. CJY-52-20 directed the Budget and Finance Committee to approve a Fund Management Plan	
23	for the COVID-19 Fund. In Resolution No. BFD-43-20 the Budget and Finance Committee	
24	approved the Fund Management Plan, attached hereto as EXHIBIT 1 .	
25	C. According to Section 1003(B)(3) of the Fund Management Plan, the Budget and Finance	
26	Committee approves budgets for the expenditure of funds from the COVID-19 Fund.	
27	Committee approves suagets for the expenditure of failes from the CO vib 15 faile.	
28	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
29	A. On behalf of the 8 Chapters listed in the attached EXHIBIT 2 , the Division of Community	
30	Development and the Department of Emergency Management are jointly requesting

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29 30 approval for payments totaling \$250,868.63 from the COVID-19 Fund, as reimbursement to said Chapters for their COVID-19 response activities and expenses. **EXHIBIT 2**.

- B. Various memoranda and Chapter Resolutions, detailing the 8 Chapters' COVID-19 response activities and expenses, are attached hereto as EXHIBIT 3. These Chapters spent a significant amount of their own emergency funds for COVID-19 response activities in their communities, because immediate help was needed for many Navajo families and individuals who were suffering greatly from COVID-19 and related economic harms.
- C. According to the Fund Management Plan for the COVID-19 Fund, the expenditure of the donations may address the needs of any Navajo Nation governmental entity. FMP, Section 1002(A)(2), Section 1004(B), and Section 1004(C)(2). The 8 Chapters are indeed "governmental entities" of the Navajo Nation, and are thus eligible for allocations from the COVID-19 Fund.
- D. The Office of the Controller has reported that there are sufficient funds in the COVID-19 Fund to cover the requested payments to the 8 Chapters. **EXHIBIT 4**.
- E. Navajo Nation Budget Forms 1, 2, and 4 for the requested total amount of \$250,868.63 are attached as EXHIBIT 5.

SECTION THREE. APPROVING \$250,868.63 FROM THE COVID-19 RESPONSE DONATION FUND TO EIGHT CHAPTERS TO REIMBURSE THEIR COVID-19 RESPONSE EXPENSES

- A. The Budget and Finance Committee hereby approves \$250,868.63 from the COVID-19 Response Donation Fund to the Division of Community Development ("DCD") for eight Chapters' COVID-19 response expenses.
- B. Upon the effective date of this Action, the Department of Emergency Management shall transfer the approved \$250,868.63 from the COVID-19 Fund to the DCD, and DCD shall then remit the designated payment amounts to each of the 8 Chapters, in the amounts shown in EXHIBIT 2.
- C. The eight Chapters receiving funds pursuant to this Action shall use the funds for continuing COVID-related relief activities.

1	SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE
2	This Action shall become effective in accordance with 2 N.N.C. §221(C).
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4	SECTION FIVE. SAVING CLAUSE
5	If any provision of this Action is determined invalid by the Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation,
6	or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the
7	remainder of this Action shall be the law of the Navajo Nation.
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
