TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE; APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE NAVAJO NATION DOMESTIC WASTEWATER REGULATIONS

PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to amend the Navajo Nation Domestic Wastewater Regulations, including amendments concerning the following: reorganizing and clarifying the permit requirements for the construction and operation of all wastewater treatment systems, updating the operator certification provisions, adding septage removal and transportation requirements, adding requirements for the use of reclaimed water and reclaimed industrial wastewater, and updating the fee schedule for construction permits, operating permits, operator certifications, and septage removal and hauling licenses.

Final Authority: Resources and Development Committee

Vote Required: Simple Majority

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review the proposed resolution in detail.

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Nation Environmental Protection Agency (or "Navajo EPA") was established, among other things, to "protect the public health and the environment of the Navajo Nation through legislative proposals, monitoring and data collection, rule making as may be authorized by the Navajo Nation Council, enforcement actions, public education, obtaining funding, and other appropriate means." 2 N.N.C. § 1922(B).
- B. The Navajo Nation Domestic Wastewater Regulations were adopted pursuant to Section 1371 of the Navajo Nation Clean Water Act (4 N.N.C. § 1371) for the purpose of seeking to promote the health and welfare of the Navajo people and to protect the environment by establishing a design review and permitting program for the construction, installation, alteration, repair, extension, operation and maintenance of domestic wastewater treatment systems.
- C. Navajo EPA is proposing amendments to the Navajo Nation Domestic Wastewater Regulations herein attached as Exhibit A.
- D. The purpose of the amendments to the Navajo Nation Domestic Wastewater Regulations includes the reorganizing and clarifying of the permit requirements for the construction and operation of all wastewater treatment systems (including minimum design requirements), updating the operator certification provisions, adding septage removal and transportation requirements, adding requirements for the use of reclaimed water and reclaimed industrial wastewater, and updating the fee schedule for construction permits, operating permits, operator certifications, and septage removal and hauling licenses.
- E. The proposed amendments were posted for public review and comment in accordance with Navajo EPA's Uniform Regulations for Permit Review, Administrative Enforcement Orders, Hearings, and Rulemakings Under Navajo Nation Environmental Acts. The comment period closed on July 28, 2023 and no comments were received.
- F. The 164 Review Form (Document Number 021150) is attached as Exhibit B, including a review by the Navajo Nation Department of Justice deeming the
