18	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
19	A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo	
20	Nation Council that has oversight authority over water, land, grazing, environment,	
21	environmental protection, cultural resources, agriculture, livestock, wildlife, roads and	
22	transportation, air transportation, communications and utilities, information	
23	technology, Chapter activities, economic and community development, commerce and	
24	trade, gaming, rights-of-way, minerals, public utilities, telecommunication, housing. 2	
25	N.N.C. § 500 (A), 2 N.N.C. § 500 (C).	
26	B. The Resources and Development Committee also is authorized to promulgate rules and	
27	regulations governing transportation, community development, land acquisitions for	
28	the Navajo Nation, environmental protection, and the use, sale, exchange, and	
29	development of Navajo Nation lands and/or resources, whether held in fee or trust	
30	status. 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B) (1).	

- C. The Resources and Development Committee grants final approval for all land withdrawals, non-mineral leases, permits, licenses, rights-of-way, surface easements and bonding requirements on Navajo Nation lands and unrestricted (fee) lands. This authority shall include subleases, modifications, assignments, leasehold encumbrances, transfers, renewals, and terminations. 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B) (2) (a).
- D. The Resources and Development Committee is authorized to represent the Navajo Nation at local, state, and federal levels, in cooperation and coordination with the President of the Navajo Nation and the appropriate Committee of the Navajo Nation Council on proposed resolutions or actions affecting natural resources; energy resources; economic and community development; road and transportation matters; capital improvement projects, including recommending approval of the annual capital improvement projects budget of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Indian Health Services and other departments or agencies of the United States; and housing development. 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B) (5).
- E. The Resources and Development Committee is the oversight committee of the Division of Natural Resources, including District Grazing Officers, Eastern Navajo Land Board, Farm Boards, Soil and Water Conservation Districts, including grazing issues to accomplish duties set forth in 3 N.N.C.§§ 832 and 852; Division of Economic Development; Division of Transportation; Environmental Protection Agency except as otherwise delegated by the Navajo Nation law; and legislative oversight to the Gaming Regulatory Office. 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C) (1).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Resources and Development Committee met on September 25th and 26th, 2023 and the Committee members discussed and deliberated on the Resources and Development Committee's overall priorities for matters within the Committee's authority.
- B. The Resources and Development Committee members agreed upon the following list of overall priorities, as shown in the attached **Exhibit A**, titled: "25th Navajo Nation Council Resources and Development Committee Priorities:" The Priorities encompass the areas of Economic Development, Community Development, Transportation,

Natural Resources, Environmental Issues, Housing, communication with other sovereigns on issues within its oversight, and review of plans of operation for Navajo Nation Divisions within the Resources and Development Committee's oversight authority, in addition to other topics.

SECTION THREE. APPROVING THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE'S PRIORITIES FOR THE FOUR-YEAR TERM OF THE 25th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL
