18	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
19	A. The Resources & Development Committee is the oversight committee for all 110 Navajo	
20	Nation Chapters. 2 N.N.C. §501(C)(1).	
21	B. As the oversight authority for Chapters, the Resources & Development Committee reviews	
22	audit reports and proposed corrective action plans regarding Chapter financial matters. 12	
23	N.N.C. §7(E).	
24	C. The Budget & Finance Committee has the final authority to review and approve audit reports	
25	issued by the Auditor General, as well as proposed corrective action plans. 12 N.N.C. §6(A)	
26	and §7(D).	
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28	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
29	A. In accordance with 12 N.N.C. §6, the Navajo Nation Office of the Auditor General has	
30	provided an internal audit report of the Sheep Springs Chapter. This report is dated September	

implementing all tasks set forth in its approved Corrective Action Plan. In compliance with 12

N.N.C. §7(F), the Sheep Springs Chapter shall submit said report to the Office of the Auditor

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- B. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §7(F)(2), the Office of the Auditor General shall receive and review the Sheep Springs Chapter's six-month status report and shall prepare a memorandum explaining the Auditor General's opinion about the success of the Sheep Springs Chapter's corrective efforts and the Chapter's compliance with its approved Corrective Action Plan during the noted six-month period.
- C. The Office of the Auditor General shall then promptly submit such memorandum along with the Sheep Springs Chapter's status report to the Resources & Development Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. §7(F)(2).
- D. Twelve months after the effective date of this Action, the Office of the Auditor General shall conduct a follow-up review of the Sheep Springs Chapter to determine whether or not the Chapter has successfully implemented its approved Corrective Action Plan. See 12 N.N.C. §7(G).
- E. The Office of the Auditor General shall then promptly prepare its twelve-month report on its findings resulting from the follow-up review. Such report shall include the Auditor General's recommended sanctions, if any, to be imposed upon the Sheep Springs Chapter for failing to sufficiently implement its Corrective Action Plan. See 12 N.N.C. §7(G).
- F. The Auditor General's follow-up report shall be presented to the Resources & Development Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee. See 12 N.N.C. §7(G); 12 N.N.C. §7(H).

SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Action shall become effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §221(C), 12 N.N.C. §6(A), and 12 N.N.C. §7(D).

SECTION SIX. SAVING CLAUSE

If any provision of this Action is determined invalid by the Navajo Supreme Court, or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Supreme Court, those provisions of this Action that are not determined invalid shall be the law of the Navajo Nation.
