17	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY
18	A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo
19	Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 500 (A).
20	B. The Resources and Development Committee oversees areas such as roads and
21	transportation, communication and utilities, economic and community development,
22	commerce and trade, rights-of-way, public utilities, and housing. 2 N.N.C. § 500 (C).
23	C. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council grants final
24	confirmation of appointments to entities under the authority of the Committee requiring
25	appointments. 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B) (9).

27	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS
28	A. The Navajo Engineering and Construction Authority is organized "[t]o engage in the
29	general engineering and construction industry." 5 N.N.C. § 1972 (A) (1).

- B. The business and affairs of the Authority shall be conducted by a Board of Directors of seven directors. 5 N.N.C. § 1973 (A).
- C. The Board of Directors shall be appointed by the President of the Navajo Nation and confirmed by the Resources and Development Committee. 5 N.N.C. § 1973 (C). See 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B) (9).
- D. At least six directors of the Board shall be enrolled members of the Navajo Nation. Individuals with experience and/or education in the engineering, construction, architectural, legal, accounting, management, or other construction related field shall be given preference for appointment to the Board. 5 N.N.C. § 1973 (D).
- E. The members of the board shall serve four-year terms. 5 N.N.C. § 1973 (C).
- F. The Navajo Nation President appointed Alton Joe Shepherd to serve as a member of the Navajo Engineering and Construction Authority Board of Directors.
- G. Appointment letter attached as **Exhibit A**; letter of interest attached as **Exhibit B**; résumé attached as **Exhibit C** and Certificate of Navajo Indian Blood attached as **Exhibit D**.

SECTION THREE. CONFIRMING APPOINTMENT

The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council confirms the appointment of Alton Joe Shepherd to serve on the Navajo Engineering and Construction Authority Board of Directors, for a term of four (4) years beginning with the certification of this resolution.
