17	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
18	A. The Naabík'iyáti' Committee is established as a Standing Committee of the Navajo Nation	
19	Council. 2 N.N.C. § 700.	
20	B. The Naabík'iyáti' Committee has the authority to approve and confirm appointments of	
21	Commissioners by the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council, to the Navajo Nation Human	
22	Rights Commission. 2 N.N.C. § 922 (A).

24	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
25	A. The Commissioners of the Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission ("NNHRC") shall be	
26	appointed by the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council and confirmed by the Naabík'iyáti'	
27	Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 922 (A).	
28	B. The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission shall consist of five commissioners with	
29	reputable and established backgrounds in the fields of education, business, law	
30	enforcement, and social services. 2 N.N.C. § 922 (A).

- C. The NNHRC commissioners shall each serve a four-year term pursuant to the NNHRC Plan of Operation as approved by Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJN-15-08. Whenever a vacancy occurs on the Commission, the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council appoints a new qualified member. NNHRC Plan of Operation, at Section IV-B, Organization/Term of Office.
- D. The Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council, by memorandum attached as **Exhibit A**, has appointed Mr. Roscoe Herrera to the Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission.
- E. Mr. Herrera has a reputable and established professional background in law enforcement, one of the four background subjects identified in 2 N.N.C. § 922 (A). Mr. Herrera's letter of interest and resume are attached as **Exhibit B**.

SECTION THREE. CONFIRMATION OF COMMISSIONER WITH BACKGROUND IN LAW ENFORCEMENT

The Naabík'iyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby confirms the appointment of Mr. Roscoe Herrera as a Commissioner on the Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission, with background in law enforcement, for a term of four years beginning October 1, 2024.
