22	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	I i
23	A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the	
24	Navajo Nation Council with the power to promulgate rules and regulations	
25	governing community development. 2 N.N.C. §§ 500(A), 501(B)(1).	
26	B. The Budget and Finance Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation	I
27	Council which is authorized to approve and accept contracts from federal	
28	authorities upon the recommendation of the standing committee which has	
29	oversight of the program which requested the contract. 2 N.N.C. §§ 300(A),	
30	301(B)(15).	

C. The Naabik'íyáti Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is authorized to approve contracts between the Navajo Nation and the United States Department of Interior for the implementation of the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, 25 U.S.C. § 5301 et seq. (P.L. 93-638, as amended). 2 N.N.C. § 701(A)(11).

## SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. It is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation and its citizens to enter into the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, 25 U.S.C. § 5301 et seq. (P.L. 93-638, as amended) contract, including the Annual Funding Agreement and Scope of Work, attached as **Exhibit A**, with the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to fund the Housing Improvement Program for a three-year term.
- B. The proposed contract, and its associated Annual Funding Agreement and Scope of Work, has been deemed sufficient via 164 Review Sheet Document Number 023175 which is attached as Exhibit B.

## SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves and authorizes the contract between the Navajo Nation and the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, under 25 U.S.C. § 5301 *et seq.* (P.L. 93-638, as amended) for a three-year term for the Housing Improvement Program attached as **Exhibit A**.
- B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves and authorizes the Annual Funding Agreement and Scope of Work for the Housing Improvement Program, for the contract term as set forth in the documents attached as **Exhibit A**.
- C. The Navajo Nation hereby authorizes the President of the Navajo Nation to execute and effectuate the contract, Annual Funding Agreement, and Scope of Work, provided the terms and conditions in such documents are substantially similar to those approved by this resolution.
