TITLE OF RESOLUTION: PROPOSED STANDING COMMITTEE RESOLUTION; AN ACTION RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE AND THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; APPROVING AN ANIMAL UNIT MONTH (AUM) FEE OF TWO-DOLLARS (\$2.00) FOR THE 2025-2035 EASTERN AGENCY GRAZING PERMIT RENTAL RATE; AND, REQUESTING APPROVAL OF THIS RATE BY THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS

PURPOSE: The purpose of the resolution is to approve a fee of \$2.00/AUM for grazing permits in the Eastern Navajo Agency and request approval of this rate by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

20	oversight authority over grazing and land matters to establish Navajo Nation

23	B. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has	
24	oversight over the Division of Natural Resources, including District Grazing

26	C. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to	
27	coordinate all federal programs with other standing committees and branches	
28	of the Navajo Nation government to provide the most efficient delivery of	
29	services to the Navajo Nation.	
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SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The purpose of the federal regulations found at 25 C.F.R. § 166.1 et seq. "is to describe the authorities, policies, and procedures the [Bureau of Indian Affairs] uses to approve, grant, and administer a permit for grazing on tribal land, individually-owned Indian land, or government land." 25 C.F.R. § 166.1(a).
- B. Pursuant to 25 C.F.R. § 166.400 (a), "[f]or tribal lands, a tribe may establish a grazing rental rate that is less or more than the grazing rental rate established by [the Bureau of Indian Affairs]. [The Bureau of Indian Affairs] will assist a tribe to establish a grazing rental rate by providing the tribe with available information concerning the value of grazing on tribal lands."
- C. The Bureau of Indian Affairs (or "BIA") is in the process of renewing grazing permits for 2025 for various grazing permits in the Eastern Navajo Agency.
- D. The current Animal Unit Month (AUM) for the Eastern Navajo Agency is \$2.00/AUM. The Navajo Nation Council's Naabik'íyáti' Committee through NABIJA-02-15, herein attached as Exhibit A, approved a fee of \$2.00/AUM for Eastern Navajo Agency Grazing Permits in 2015.
- E. The United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Eastern Navajo Agency, Agency Superintendent, by letter dated September 23, 2024, herein attached as **Exhibit B**, "recommends the rate of \$8.00/Animal Unit Month (AUM) with the minimum rate of \$6.00/AUM for tribal trust lands and individual Indian Allotments."
- F. Resolutions from the Eastern Navajo Joint Land Board (Resolution # ENJLB-10-2024-002), the Navajo Nation Eastern Agency Council (No. EALBD-16-2024-10-01S) herein attached as Exhibit C support the grazing permit rental rate to remain at \$2.00/AUM).
- G. As stated in the Navajo Nation Eastern Agency Council (No. EALBD-16-2024-10-01S), "most Navajo people including grazing permittees are not commercial producers and have utilized livestock such as sheep, goats, cattle, and horses as cultural means of survival for sustenance, clothing, arts and crafts, and transportation" and "the abrupt increase in grazing permit rental fees will cause

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further burdens—financial, emotional and unneeded stress—to the grazing permittees, the majority of whom are elderly Navajo people who receive a limited monthly income [.]"

H. The Resources and Development Committee finds it is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation to request that BIA continue the rate of \$2.00/AUM for grazing permittees in the Eastern Navajo Agency.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

The Naabik'íyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby approves a fee of \$2.00/AUM for grazing permits in the Eastern Navajo Agency and requests approval of this rate by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
