**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this proposed resolution is to amend CAP-24-21, which established The Navajo Nation Hashkééjí Nahat'á Báeso Bá Hooghan Fund.

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19	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
20	A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation and empowered	
21	to enact positive law of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 102(A) and 164(A).	
22	B. The Naabik'iyati' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review all	
23	proposed legislation which requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C.	
24	§ 164(A)(9).	
25	C. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to	
26	review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation,

#### **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

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- A. In 2014, the Navajo Nation filed a lawsuit against the U.S. Department of the Interior for violating the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, 25 U.S.C. §§ 450 et. seq., by partially declining the Navajo Nation's annual funding requests for the operation of the Navajo Nation Judicial Branch. The U.S. Court of Appeals on April 2, 2017, and the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia on June 12, 2020 on ruled in favor of the Navajo Nation. The Navajo Nation was awarded \$18,279,923.32 including statutory interest to the date of the award.
  - B. As a result of the federal court decision and award, on April 19, 2021, the Navajo Nation Council approved Council Resolution CAP-24-21 "RELATING TO BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, LAW AND ORDER COMMITTEE AND NAABIK'IYATI' COMMITTEE AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL: ESTABLISHING THE NAVAJO NATION HASHKÉÉJÍ NAHAT'Á BÁESO BÁ HOOGHAN BY AMENDING TITLE TWELVE OF THE NAVAJO NATION CODE; DIRECTING THAT THE AWARD RECEIVED THROUGH NAVAJO NATION V. DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, NO. 14-cv-1909 (TSC), BE DEPOSITED IN THE HASHKÉÉJÍ NAHAT'Á BÁESO BÁ HOOGHAN AFTER REIMBURSEMENT OF LITIGATION COSTS; DIRECTING THAT THE PROCEEDS FROM FUTURE LITIGATIONS RELATED TO THE JUDICIAL BRANCH'S P.L. 93-638 CONTRACTS OR ANNUAL FUNDING AGREEMENTS BE DEPOSITED IN THE HASHKÉÉJÍ NAHAT'Á BÁESO BÁ HOOGHAN; ESTABLISHING THAT THE FIXED COST LITIGATION ACCOUNT SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR LITIGATION COSTS)."
- C. Council Resolution CAP-24-21, attached as Exhibit A, established the "Hashkééji Nahat'á Béeso Ba Hooghan" Fund (the "Fund") to deposit the \$18,279,923.32 including statutory interest to the date of the award, less costs to the litigate the lawsuit. The Fund was established in 12 N.N.C. §§ 2801 2809.
- D. To expend the Fund Principal and Interest, the Fund states "[t]he Fund Principal and Income shall be expended upon recommendation by the Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation Supreme Court through an annual or multi-year expenditure plan approved by the

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Law and Order and the Budget and Finance Committees. Any changes or modification to an approved expenditure plan shall be approved by the Law and Order Committee and Budget and Finance Committee upon the recommendation of the Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation." 12 N.N.C. § 2805(A).

E. This legislation is offered amend 12 N.N.C. § 2805(A) to allow the Law and Order Committee, to independently approve the annual or multi-year expenditure plan, without the Budget and Finance Committee, upon the recommendation of the Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation Supreme Court.

# SECTION THREE. AMENDING 12 N.N.C. § 2805(A) OF THE NAVAJO NATION HASHKÉÉJÍ NAHAT'Á BÉESO BÁ HOOGHAN

The Navajo Nation hereby amends 12 N.N.C. § 2805(A) of the Hashkééji Nahat'á Béeso Ba Hooghan, as follows:

#### Title 12. FISCAL MATTERS

## CHAPTER 28. NAVAJO NATION HASHKÉÉJÍ NAHAT'Á BÉESO BÁ HOOGHAN

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### § 2805. Expenditure of the Fund

A. The Fund Principal and Income shall be expended upon recommendation by the Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation Supreme Court through an annual or multi-year expenditure plan approved by the <a href="Law and Order Committee-and-Budget and-Finance-Committees">Law and Order Committee</a> and <a href="Budget-and-Finance-Committee">Budget and Finance-Committee</a> upon the recommendation of the Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation.

# The provisions of this Act shall become effective upon adoption by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the Navajo Nation Council and approval of the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(17) and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005(C)(10), (11), and (12). SECTION FIVE. CODIFICATION The provisions of these amendments of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel shall incorporate such amendments in the next codification of the Navajo Nation Code. SECTION SIX. SAVING CLAUSE Should any provision of these amendments be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Court of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those amendments that are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.
